

# Reminder: New Budget in Effect

The new water budget went into effect April 1, 2015, after an extensive public review and hearing.

## What Does this Mean for You?

MNWD has recalculated customer water budgets to encourage conservation, efficient use of water, and improve the reliability of our supplies



### INDOOR WATER BUDGET

Indoor water budgets have been reduced from 65 gallons per person per day to **60 gallons per person per day**.



### OUTDOOR WATER BUDGET

Outdoor water budgets have been reduced to **sustain a mix of California native plants and lawn**, not a full lawn.

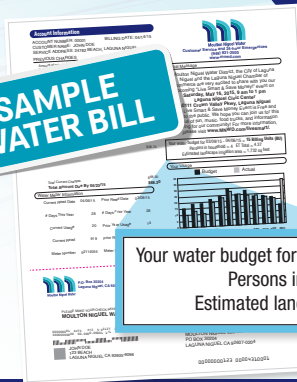

Your water budget for 03/09/15 - 04/06/15 = 15 Billing Units (BU)  
Persons in household = 4 ET Total = 4.37  
Estimated landscape irrigation area = 1,732 sq feet

(1 BU = 748 gallons of water)
